Gjøco Murfärg is a matt, permeable paint for outdoor use on mineral substrates. Paint contains effective film conserving agent that counteract mold growth and has good weather resistance. The paint is particularly suitable for masonry, concrete and plaster, both untreated and previously painted. Not suitable for use on super Eternit. When used on concrete and cement, moisture and concrete skin need to be checked. The paint is also suitable for moisture exposed surfaces indoors as in basements, garages etc.

Pretreatment

The surface must be clean and dry. Clean with Gjøco Hustvätt or Gjøco Krafttvätt to remove grease, dirt and contaminants. Follow the instructions on the

Other information	Application temperature in air and substrate must be at least + 10°C. Stir well before use. Different production numbers are mixed before use. Replace the lid well after use to prevent spillage and drying. Liquid paint must not be emptied into drains or watercourses, but delivered to the environmental protection station. Disposal of waste	Liquid paint must not be emptied into sewers or into nature, but must be delivered to an approved hazardous waste collection point. Empty, clean and dry plastic packaging without handle, can delivered as plastic waste.
Storage	Seal the lid tightly when storing paint to prevent spillage and drying. The paint must be transported and stored upright, dry and frost-free.
Directions for use	Gjøco Murfärg is ready for use and must not be thinned. When using Gjøco Murfärg at Eternit, it is recommended to test the adhesion through test painting.
	packaging. Old loose paint, loose plaster and dust must be removed by brushing / scraping. It is important that the substrate is firm to get good adhesion. Absorbent, porous or heavily limed surfaces are primed with Gjøco Murseis or Mineral primmer. New plastered surfaces should be dried at least 4 weeks before overcoating. All construction deficiencies must be addressed before the painting work begins. Surfaces affected by algae and mold are treated with Gjøco Algrent. Stir well. Contents of tins with different production numbers should be mixed. During unfavourable drying conditions (high humidity, fog, rain, low temperatures), glossy, lightly sticky streaks may occur on the paint film.
