Gjøco Primer for masonry and concrete is suitable for use on untreated masonry, concrete, brick, plaster and concrete roof tiles before painting with a suitable top coat. Bricks must be plastered before painting. The primer is also well suited as a dust binder and impregnation on garage floors, walls, etc. where paint is not desired. Recommended as a primer for roof tiles before painting with Gjøco Takdekk. The primer seals the pores in the roof tiles, and prevents frost cracking and flaking.

Pretreatment

Loose masonry and plaster should be brushed/scraped. On new concrete/walls that are to be painted after priming with Gjøco Primer for masonry and concrete, the cement film must be removed by mechanical grinding. Cement and concrete roof tiles should be cleaned with Gjøco Husvask and a high-pressure washer. It is important that loose particles, algae, fungus, moss and other contamination are removed. The substrate must be dry before Gjøco Primer for masonry and concrete is applied. When using on concrete and cement elements, any moisture and release coating must be checked.

Gjøco Primer for masonry and concrete is ready to use and should not normally be thinned. Apply 1-2 coats depending on the nature and absorbency of the substrate. The primer should absorb into the substrate and not form a film. Apply with a roller, brush or spray.		
Seal the lid tightly when storing paint to prevent spillage and drying. The paint must be transported and stored upright, dry and frost-free.		
Liquid paint must not be emptied into sewers or into nature, but must be delived an approved hazardous waste collection point. Empty, clean and dry plastic packaging without handling, can be delivered as plastic waste.		
Stir well before use. Package sizes: 0.75 and 10 liters.
