Application Method:	Connect the canister to the garden hose, and the dosing happens automatically. Spray generously to thoroughly wet the growth. A repeated treatment should be considered for heavy growth, preferably with 2-3 weeks in between. Dead material is removed once it turns brown, either naturally by rain and wind or by brushing or rinsing. Note: A pressure washer on the roof should be used with caution. When treating delicate surfaces, such as textiles, the product should not be allowed to dry but should be rinsed off. If unsure whether the material can withstand the treatment, it is recommended to test on a small area first.	
Storage:	The product should be transported and stored upright, in a dry and frost-free environment.	
Waste Disposal:	The product should not be emptied into sewage systems or the natural environment but should be taken to a recycling station. Empty, clean, and dry plastic packaging can be disposed of as plastic waste.	
Additional Information:	It is not recommended to remove the ejector from the packaging, as this may cause leakage. Packaging sizes: 2.5 liters.
